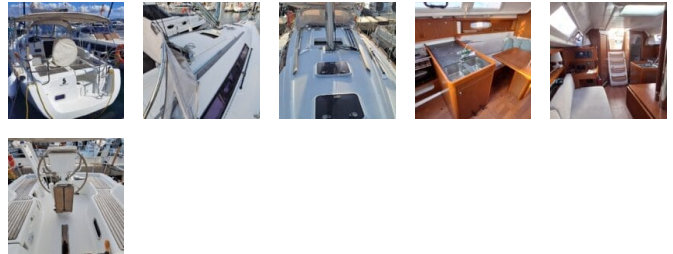


Bénéteau Oceanis 31 - 75,000 €
