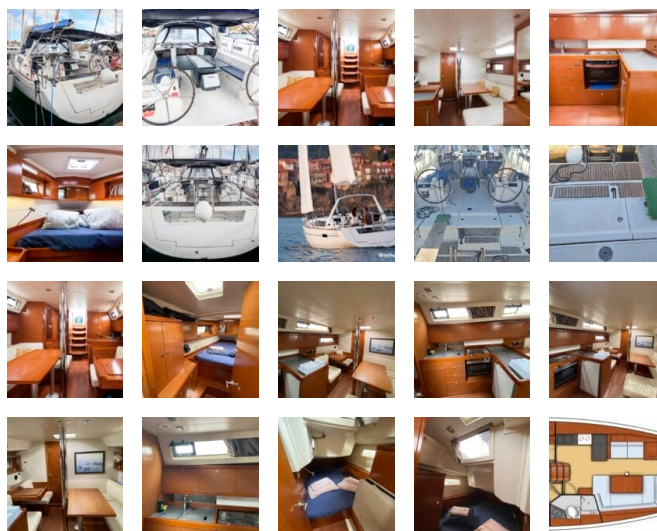


Bénéteau Oceanis 41 - 160,000 €
