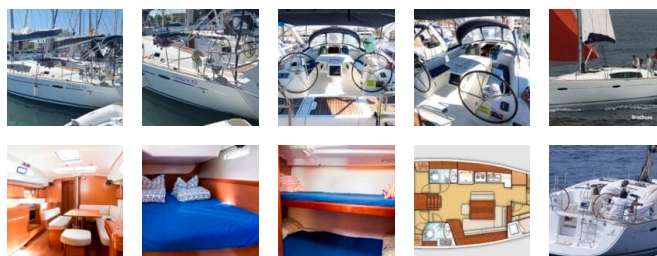


Bénéteau Oceanis 43 - 160,000 €
